BSX #6 - Stewardship

Sustained and concentrated growth in Godliness by the quality of my oversight of the income, management, spending and giving of my finances

BSX #7 - Evangelism

Sustained and concentrated growth in Godliness by the quality and frequency of my witness to Christ

Wherefore I put thee in remembrance that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands.
