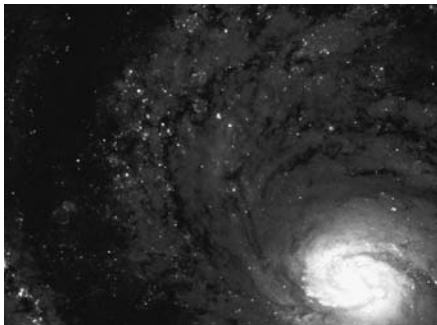

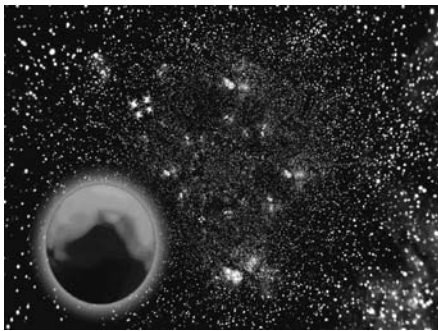

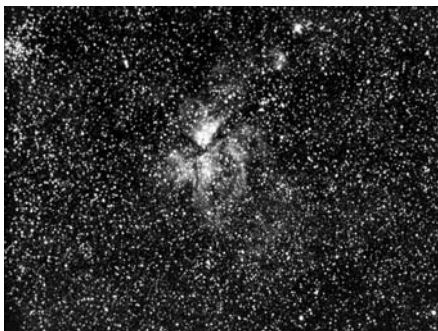

Which maketh Arcturus, Orion, and Pleiades, and the chambers of the south.

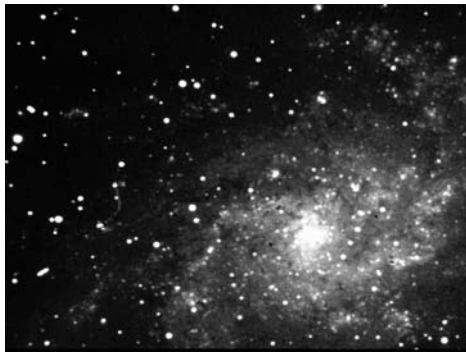
Which doeth great things past finding out; yea, and wonders without number. (Job 9:8-10)

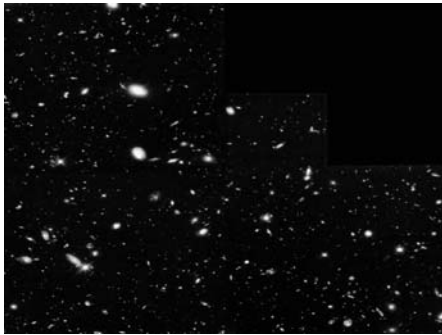
There is no speech nor language, where their voice is not heard.
