In the beginning God created the heaven and Great Enough To Provide An Eternal Future the earth. (Genesis 1:1) For thus saith the Lord that created the heavens: God himself that formed the earth and Three Heavens made it: he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the Lord; and there is none else. (Isaiah 45:18) And he said, Hear thou therefore the word of the Lord: I saw the Lord sitting on his throne, The Bright Future and all the host of heaven standing by him on his right hand and on his left. (1 Kings 22:19) 1. Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named... (Ephesians 3:15) 2. And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God: (Revelation 19:1) To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God... (Ephesians 3:1 Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us... Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; (Hebrews 12:1-2) Knowest thou the ordinances of heaven? canst thou set the dominion thereof in the earth? (Job 38:33) Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. (Matthew 6:10)



10. (Hebrews 13:14) And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem... 14. (Revelation 21:2) In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. (John 14:2) And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and one sat on the 15. (Revelation 4:2) throne. I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne was like the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire. A fiery stream issued and came forth from before him: thousand thousands ministered unto 16. him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him: the judgment was set, and the books were opened. (Daniel 7:9-10) To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame,

and am set down with my Father in his throne.
