(Colossians 1:20)

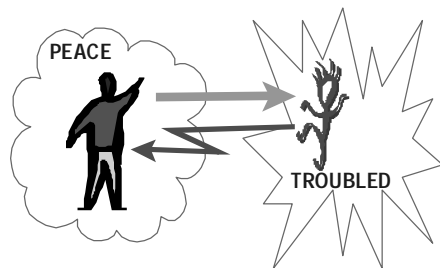
And your feet shod with the preparation of the
