The Difficulty of Knowing Who is Really Friend

And one shall say unto him, What are these wounds in thine hands? Then he shall answer, Those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends. (Zechariah 13:6)

Wealth maketh many friends; but the poor is separated from his neighbour. (Proverbs 19:4)

Many will intreat the favour of the prince: and every man is a friend to him that giveth gifts. (Proverbs 19:6):

Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood, and hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen. (Revelations 1:5-6)

He that speaketh flattery to his friends, even the eyes of his children shall fail. (Job 17:5) A man that flattereth his neighbour spreadeth (Proverbs 29:5) a net for his feet. ...meddle not with him that flattereth with his (Proverbs 20:19) My kinsfolk have failed, and my familiar friends have forgotten me. (Job 19:4) My lovers and my friends stand aloof from my sore; and my kinsmen stand afar off. (Psalm 38:11) I behaved myself as though he had been my friend or brother: I bowed down heavily, as one that mourneth for his mother. But in mine adversity they rejoiced, and gathered themselves together: yea, the abjects gathered themselves together against me, and I knew it not; they did tear me, and ceased With hypocritical mockers in feasts, they gnashed upon me with their teeth. (Psalm 35:14-16) Yea, mine own familiar friend, in whom I trusted, which did eat of my bread, hath lifted up his heel against me. (Psalm 41:9) For it was not an enemy that reproached me: then I could have borne it: neither was it he that hated me that did magnify himself against me; then I would have hid myself from him: But it was thou, a man mine equal, my guide, and mine acquaintance. We took sweet counsel together, and walked unto the house of God in company. (Psalm 55:12-14) Greet ye one another with a kiss of charity. Peace be with you all that are in Christ Five Kinds of Kisses In The Bible Jesus. Amen. (1 Peter 5:14) 1. (aspazomai) to enfold in the arms, Greet: salute, to welcome (philema) a kiss Kiss: Charity: (agape) love as in affection or benevolence: Greet one another with an holy kiss. (2 Corinthians 13:12) Holy: (hagios) sacred (physically pure, morally blameless and consecrated) Greet all the brethren with an holy kiss. (1 Thessalonians 5:26)

Understand the difficulty of correcting friendships lies in My kinsfolk have failed, and my familiar friends knowing who is really a friend have forgotten me. 2. Establish Biblical categories that define relationships They that dwell in mine house, and my maids, count me for a stranger: (Job 19:13-15) **Biblical Categories of Relationships** 1. ...and there is a friend that sticketh closer than a brother. (Proverbs 18:24) Henceforth I call you not servants... but I have called you friends; (John 15:15) 2. Peace be to the brethren, and love with faith... Grace be with all them that love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen. (Ephesians 6:23-24) 3. A friend loveth at all times... (Proverbs 17:17) 4. My kinsfolk have failed, and my familiar friends have forgotten me. (Job 19:140 5. But it was thou, a man mine equal, my guide, and mine acquaintance. (Psalm 55:13) 6. Lest strangers be filled with thy wealth; and thy labours be in the house of a stranger; And thou (Proverbs 5:10-11) mourn at the last... 7. He that is not with me is against me: and he that gathereth not with me scattereth. (Luke 11:23)
