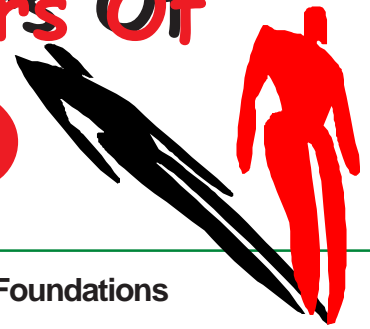

Hear, ye children, the instruction of a father, and attend to know understanding. (Proverbs 4:1)

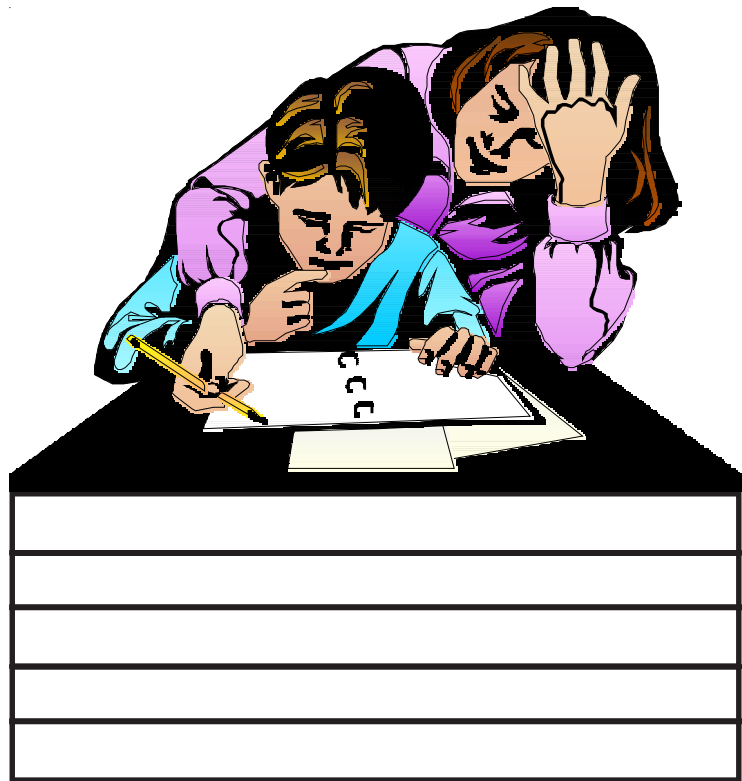
Hearken unto thy father that begat thee... (Proverbs 23:22)

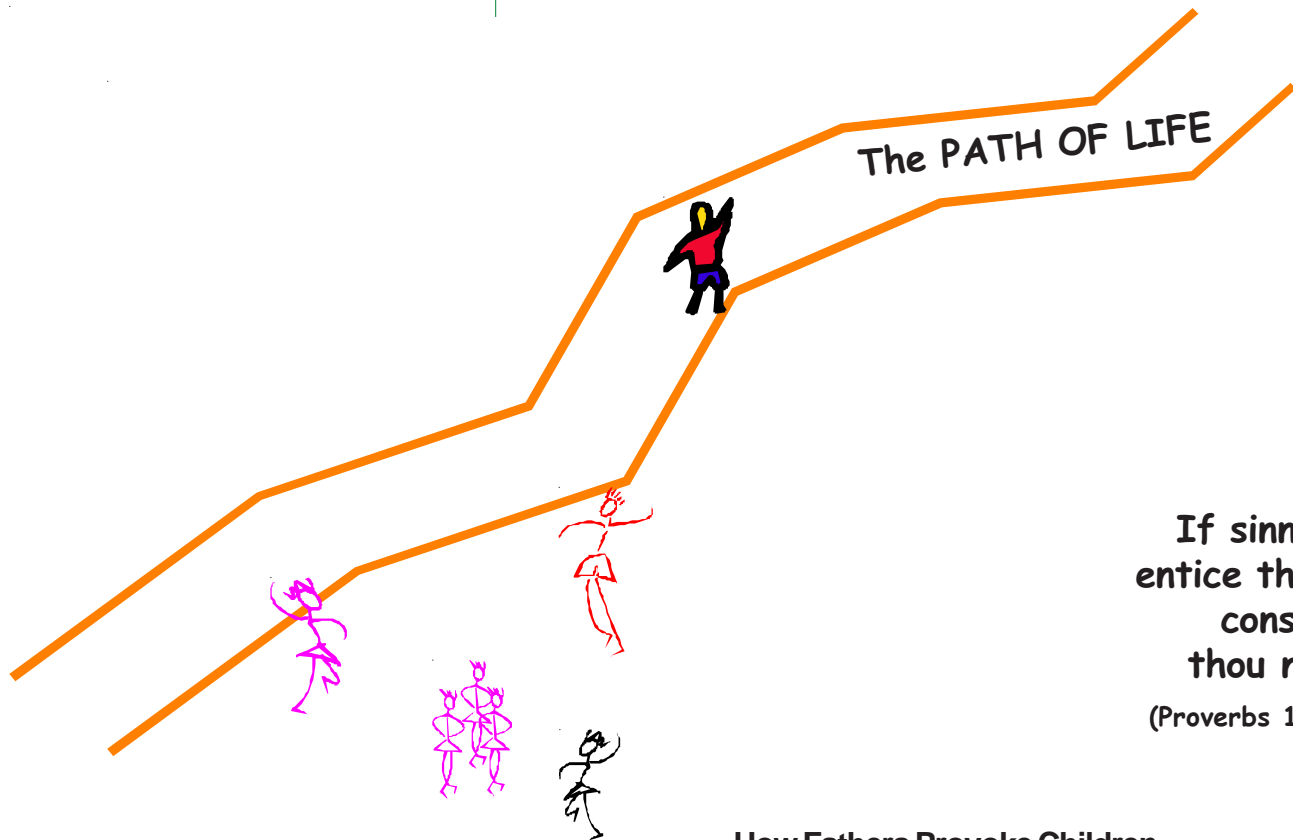
