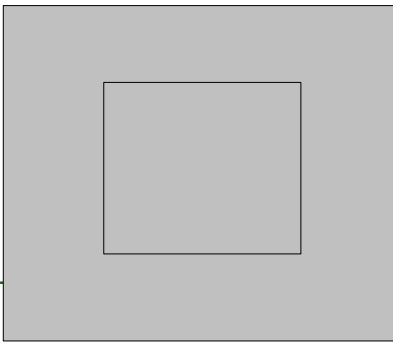


# How To Transition To REIGNING
